Sunset Review of the 090 Staff Data - Responsibilities Tony Wallette	Action Item
Tony Wallette presented to the ITF Committee the need to continue collecting the 090 Staff Responsibilities Data Record. The information collected provides the job responsibilities of all professional district and ESC staff and the time spent performing professional duties and if applicable, the number of students receiving services. This data allows the TEA to calculate the Portion of a Full Time Equivalent (PFTE) that corresponds with each job responsibility. The sum of the PFTE for teachers and the number of students involved are used to determine class size and the student teacher/ratio. The job responsibility (ROLE) is used to identify various groups of staff for reporting total FTE by group and identifying groups of staff for funding considerations and evaluations of programs. The ROLE and SERVICE are used to determine classes being taught by teachers not certified in the content area of their respective class.
