I. NEW TECH INDICATOR AND EXPANSION OF CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION



BACKGROUND



- <u>HB 3</u>, Section 1.030 modified the Career and Technology Education (CTE) Allotment to include funding for campuses that are members of the New Tech Network.
- Additionally, HB3, Section 1.030, expanded eligibility for the CTE Allotment to include students in grades seven and eight, which was previously limited to students in Career and Technical Education for the Disabled (CTED) courses.



Sec. <u>48.106</u> [<u>42.154</u>]. CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION ALLOTMENT (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily attendance in an approved career and technology education program in grades <u>7</u> [<u>nine</u>] through 12 [or in career and technology education programs for students with disabilities in grades seven through 12], a district is entitled to:

(1) an annual allotment equal to the [adjusted] basic allotment multiplied by a weight of 1.35; and

(2) \$50 for each of the following in which [, if] the student is enrolled:

(A) [in] two or more advanced career and technology education classes for a total of three or more credits;

(B) a campus designated as a P-TECH school under Section 29.556; or

<u>(C) a campus that is a member of the New Tech</u> <u>Network and that focuses on project-based learning and work-based</u> <u>education</u>.

NEW-TECH-INDICATOR-CODE



- NEW-TECH-INDICATOR-CODE (E1647) has been added to the StudentExtension complex type to be reported in the PEIMS Fall, Summer, and Extended Year Submissions.
- Definition: NEW-TECH-INDICATOR-CODE indicates that a student in grades 7-12 is enrolled in a New Tech Network campus as identified by the New Tech Network.
- Limited to campuses where the LEA has signed an agreement with the New Tech Network.
- Although the New Tech Network campuses may serve any grade range, this data element will not be reported for students below grade 7.

• This rule assists districts in verifying that students enrolled in a New Tech Network campus are reported with the NEW-TECH-INDICATOR-CODE.

 Students who are reported as participating in the New Tech Network program on the PEIMS Fall snapshot date must be enrolled in a campus that has entered into an agreement with the New Tech Network.

	A student reported as enrolled in a New Tech Network campus must have Attendance or Flexible Attendance in a TX- CampusIdOfEnrollment that is a New Tech Network campus.			

 Students who are reported as participating in the New Tech Network program in PEIMS Submission 3 must report attendance or flexible attendance in a campus that has entered into an agreement with the New Tech Network.

40110 -0127	If GRADE-LEVEL-CODE is "0 <mark>7</mark> "-"12" and CAREER-AND- TECHNICAL-ED-IND-CD is "1", then there should be Career and Technical Education Attendance and/or Career and Technical Education Flexible Attendance data reported.	S	3	District, Campus, Charter
	A student in grades "0 <mark>7</mark> "-"12" that is enrolled in a career and technical education course should be reported with career and technical education attendance and/or flexible attendance.			

• Students in grades 7 through 12 who are enrolled in a career and technical education course should be reported with CTE attendance or flexible attendance.

42410- 0003 DELETED RULE	For each Career and Technical Education Attendance data item, if GRADE-LEVEL-CODE is "07" or "08", there must be a matching Special Education Attendance data item (Special Programs Attendance with ATTENDANCE-EVENT-INDICATOR of "Regular - SpecialEd"), or there must be matching Special Programs Attendance where ATTENDANCE-EVENT-INDICATOR is "Regular - SpecialEdMainstream" and TOTAL-ELIG-SP-ED- MAINSTREAM-DAYS-PRESENT is greater than 0.	ŧ	3	District, Campus, Charter
	A CTE student in grade 7 or 8 is not eligible for CTE attendance funding unless they are also reported with special education attendance. Only grade 7 and 8 special education students who are participating in the CTE Program for the Disabled are eligible for CTE attendance funding. NOTE: Refer to "Special Note about Attendance Context Rules" for guidance on matching attendance data.			

• CTE attendance funding for 7th and 8th graders is no longer limited to students taking Career and Technical Education for the Disabled (CTED) courses.
