OVERVIEW



Other Legislative Changes:

- High School Equivalency Program (HB 1051)
 - HB 1051, passed in the 86th Legislative Session, amended TEC 42.006 by adding Subsection (a-8) and (a-9) that requires local education agencies (LEAs) who have been identified as a Dropout Recovery School (DRS) to report through PEIMS, students who enroll in a High School Equivalency Program (HSEP), a dropout recovery program, or an adult education program provided under a high school diploma and industry certification charter school program and who:
 - are age 18-25,
 - have not been previously reported to TEA as dropouts, and
 - enroll in the program after not attending school for a period of at least nine months.
- Industry Certification Exam Fees and Vendors
 - Under House Bill 3 (HB 3), local education agencies (LEAs) are entitled to a reimbursement to help defray the cost of industry certification exams. Each LEA cannot receive more than one reimbursement per student and a student may not receive more than one subsidy. These indicators will also be added to TREx, if a student moves between LEAs, the new LEA will need to know if the reimbursement happened since it is only one per student. Funds to reimburse LEAs that pay for an industry certification for a student will be provided by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to LEAs as authorized under HB 3.

Other Legislative Changes – CONT'D:

Remove OnRamps

 OnRamps is a dual enrollment program founded by the University of Texas at Austin (UT) in 2011 to increase the number and diversity of students who engage in learning experiences aligned with the expectations of leading universities. The ONRAMPS-DUAL-ENROLLMENT-INDICATOR-CODE (E1597), collected in the PEIMS Summer Submission and PEIMS Extended Year Submission, indicates whether the student has successfully completed an OnRamps dual enrollment course. The Performance Reporting Division at the Texas Education Agency (TEA) now receives this information directly from UT, so it is no longer necessary to collect the data in PEIMS.

HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY PROGRAM (HB 1051)

HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY PROGRAM (HB 1051) tsở

- New Data Element added to StudentExtension Complex Type to be reported in the PEIMS Fall and Summer Submissions:
 - ADULT-PREVIOUS-ATTENDANCE-INDICATOR-CODE (E1660)
 - Definition: Indicates whether an adult student (age 18-25) who is currently enrolled in a high school equivalency program, dropout recovery school or other adult education program (under TEC Section 29.259), has or has not attended school in the previous nine months prior to enrolling.
 - Special Instructions:

This Data Element is only to be reported by LEAs identified as a Dropout Recovery School campus.

- ADULT-PREVIOUS-ATTENDANCE-INDICATOR-CODE = 1 means, Yes, they have attended school in the previous nine months prior to enrolling in one of the above mentioned programs.
- ADULT-PREVIOUS-ATTENDANCE-INDICATOR-CODE = 0 means, No, they have not attended school in the previous nine months prior to enrolling in one of the above mentioned programs.

INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION EXAM FEES AND VENDORS



- Two New Data Elements to be added to the StudentExtension Complex Type for the PEIMS Fall and Summer Submissions:
 - IBC-EXAM-FEE-AMOUNT (E16XX)
 - IBC-EXAM-FEE-AMOUNT identifies the amount of money that was paid for a student's industry certification exam by the local education agency.
 - IBC-VENDOR-CODE (E16XX)
 - IBC-VENDOR-CODE identifies the organization or company that offered the service.
 - Utilizes new code table (C226) VENDOR-CODE

- A crosswalk will be available for LEAs to cross check vendors that are specifically aligned with certifications.
- IBC Approved Vendor Crosswalk will be available on TEA CTE and IBC Reimbursement webpages.
- The crosswalk will show each certification aligned with their respective C214 codes and each vendor with their respective C226 codes.
 - LEAs should have the ability to only submit vendors that are directly aligned to the specific certification.

 - If SERVICE-ID is not a high school course, then DUAL-CREDIT-INDICATOR-CODE must be "0" or blank/not reported, ONRAMPS-DUAL-ENROLLMENT-INDICATOR-CODE must be "0" or blank/not reported, and COLLEGE-CREDIT-HOURS must be 0 or blank/not reported.

 - For a Course Transcript, if DUAL-CREDIT-INDICATOR-CODE is "1" or ONRAMPS-DUAL-ENROLLMENT-INDICATOR-CODE is "1", then there should be Attendance and/or Flexible Attendance for that student where GRADE-LEVEL-CODE is "09"-"12".
