VENDOR COORDINATION:

Scheduled meetings with each pilot vendor to assist with their specific issues.



PILOT LEA WEBINARS:

Three webinars with all 34 Pilot LEAs to provide specific guidance and use case testing for pilot data submissions.

Provide better identification and explanation of errors for troubleshooting

TEA will inform any LEA accepted to the 2023-2024 Parallel Submission via email.

VENDOR EXPECTATIONS





PARTICIPATION & DATA SUBMISSIONS

- All vendors are required to participate in the 2023-2024 Parallel Submission.
- All vendors should provide "live" data, whenever possible, for parallel testing.
- All vendors should ensure data is available prior to published due dates.



TRAINING & SUPPORT

- All vendors are responsible for providing any appliable training for their product(s).
- All vendors are responsible for resolving Level 1 errors in a timely manner.
- All vendors should obtain access to the TSDS Vendor Support Portal to submit issues to TEA.



VENDOR READINESS

- All vendors are required obtain a TSDS Compatible Designation by the 2024-2025 Go-Live year.
- All vendors are required to test and support each of their TSDS data submissions.
- All SIS and HR/Finance vendors will need to obtain the necessary Ed-Fi certification.



ESC EXPECTATIONS



PARTICIPATION & DATA SUBMISSIONS

- All ESCs are required to participate in the 2023-2024 Parallel Submission.
- All ESCs should coordinate with their vendor for onboarding and support.
- All ESCs should test and verify their required TSDS PEIMS submissions.



TRAINING & SUPPORT

- All ESCs are responsible for providing TSDS training to their participating LEAs.
- All ESCs are responsible for Level 2 support for their participating LEAs.
- All ESCs should attend webinars and continuous trainings throughout the Parallel Submission.



FEEDBACK & RESPONSE

- All ESCs are responsible for ensuring active LEA participation throughout the Parallel Submission.
- All ESCs should develop effective strategies to solicit feedback from their participating LEAs.
- All ESCs should share best practices and be actively involved in vetting TEA resources.



LEA EXPECTATIONS





PARTICIPATION & DATA SUBMISSIONS

- All LEAs accepted by TEA are required to participate in at least one TSDS data submission.
- All LEAs should coordinate with their vendor(s) for onboarding and support.
- All LEAs should attend the TSDS training provided by their ESC prior to testing.



ACCESS & TESTING

- All LEAs are required to obtain the appropriate access to the parallel environment.
- All LEAs should compare data, validations, and reports to complete their testing.
- All LEAs should collaborate with their ESC and vendor(s) on identified issues.



FEEDBACK & RESPONSE

- All LEAs should implement effective strategies to ensure continuous progress.
- All LEAs should coordinate with their ESC and vendor(s) to develop best practices.
- All LEAs should submit enhancement requests through TIMS tickets.



ONBOARDING GUIDANCE



The onboarding strategy may vary from vendor to vendor and product to product.

A vendor may choose to onboard their LEAs in stages to ensure a high level of support.

A vendor may choose to establish testing cohorts based upon TSDS data submissions.

A vendor should have all their participating LEAs onboarded successfully by January 2024.

A vendor must have their LEAs certify their data submissions for TSDS Compatible Designation.





LEVERAGING FROM PILOT







Includes Field Coordination Network and vendor webinars, as well as submissionbased webinars for participating LEAs.



Includes resources, guidance, and specific use cases to assist in testing for each TSDS data submission.

Includes vendor meetings with TEA to provide guidance, resolve roadblocks, and ensure effective progress.



Includes Software Development Kit, Staging environment, Swagger, Ed-Fi Handbook, and technical guidance documents.

Communicate

Prior to Onboarding

Reach out to each accepted LEA to establish or identify the onboarding plan to set expectations on training and support.



Provide Training

Prior to Testing





Obtain Access

Prior to Training

Provide guidance and support for each accepted LEA to obtain the necessary access for the parallel environment.



Support Throughout

Effectively monitor progress and actively support the participating LEAs throughout the Parallel Submission year.
