OnRamps Dual Enrollment Indicator

On Ramps Dual Enrollment Data and Reports



- OnRampsIndicator (E3120) indicates that a student has completed an OnRamps dual enrollment course.
- College hours issued and accepted in the UT OnRamps program will continue to be determined by a report from the UT OnRamps program staff.
 - College hours may be reported for a student who passes the course, though declines to accept the college credit from the University of Texas at Austin.
 - The student may be reported as passing an OnRamps course without reporting college hours.
- OnRampsIndicator will display on the following reports:
 - **PDM3-133-002** Students Completing Courses with Advanced/Dual Credit/Enrollment
 - OnRamps will be a selection parameter
 - **PDM3-120-008** Students with Dual Credit Courses and College Credit Hours

Special Education (SPED) Changes

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)

- Program area guidance concerning ECSE (SPEDProgSvc E3058 Descriptor ‘19’) now defines that students served in ECSE cannot be enrolled in kindergarten classes.

DR7

19 – Early Childhood Special Education Services
Definition
The Early Childhood Special Education Services special education program service indicates whether the preschool student, age three through five years old and not in kindergarten, is receiving any special education and related services from the school district or charter school in any setting(s) or environment. [See 19 TAC §89.1035, and 34 CFR §300.101(b)]
Special Instructions
Students, three through five years old (not in kindergarten), previously reported with the Early Childhood Special Education Services descriptor, who are six years old as of the PEIMS Fall snapshot date (last Friday in October), should not be reported with the descriptor.
The Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) Services can only be reported for students receiving special education services who are at least three and less than six years of age and not in kindergarten on the PEIMS Fall snapshot date. All students receiving special education services under IDEA Part B who are ages three through five (not in kindergarten), as of the PEIMS Fall snapshot date (last Friday in October), are participating in ECSE program and must be reported as Early Childhood Special Education Services regardless of their disability or instructional setting.
ECSE is a Texas term which refers to a federally funded program under IDEA Part B which is targeted specifically for three- through five-year-old (not in kindergarten) students receiving special education and related services. ECSE includes students whose only special education service is speech therapy regardless of where the services are provided.
Each LEA shall ensure that a continuum of alternative placements is available to meet the needs of students with disabilities for special education and related services. (34CFR §300.115) For three- through five-year-old (not in kindergarten) students receiving ECSE services, the LEA continuum could include but is not limited to:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• LEA or Community Childcare Programs• Prekindergarten Programs• Head Start Programs• Home Environment• Special Education Resource Settings• Special Education Self Contained Settings• LEA or Community Therapy Settings (Speech, OT/PT, etc.)

Special Education (SPED) Changes

Early Childhood Special Education

- Rules 41163-0014 and 41163-0016 have been updated to reflect this fundamental change in the ECSE program.

41163-0014	On the PEIMS Fall snapshot date, if a SPEDProgramSvc of Early Childhood Special Education Services ("19") is reported, then age on the PEIMS Fall snapshot date must be 3, 4, or 5, EntryGradeLevel must not be "KG" , and a SPEDProgramSvc of Early Childhood Intervention Services ("20") must not be reported.	Fatal	PEIMS Fall
	A student receiving Early Childhood Special Education Services must be 3, 4, or 5 years old on the PEIMS Fall snapshot date, must not be in KG , and is not eligible to receive Early Childhood Intervention Services.		
41163-0016	On the PEIMS Fall snapshot date, if age is 3, 4, or 5, EntryGradeLevel is not "KG" , and ADAEligibility is not "0", then a SPEDProgramSvc of Early Childhood Special Education Services ("19") must be reported.	Fatal	PEIMS Fall
	A student not in kindergarten that is 3 - 5 years old on the PEIMS Fall snapshot date, with ADAEligibility indicating they are In Membership, must receive Early Childhood Special Education Services.

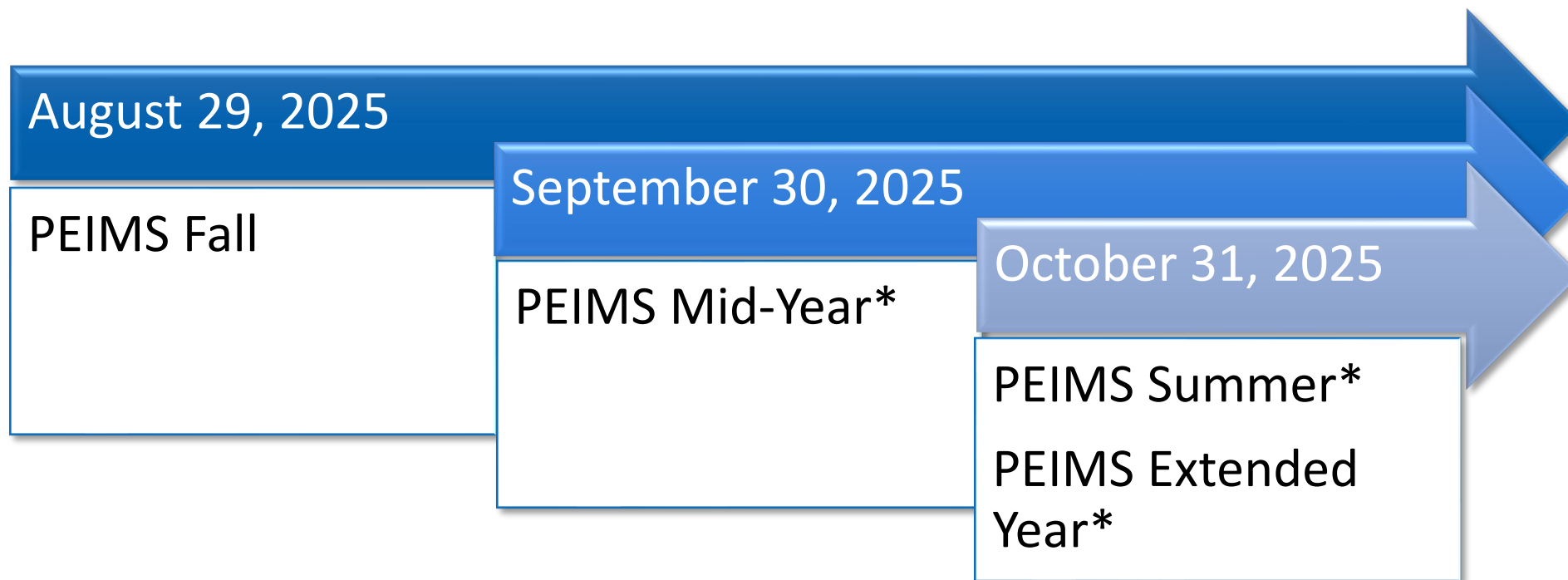
